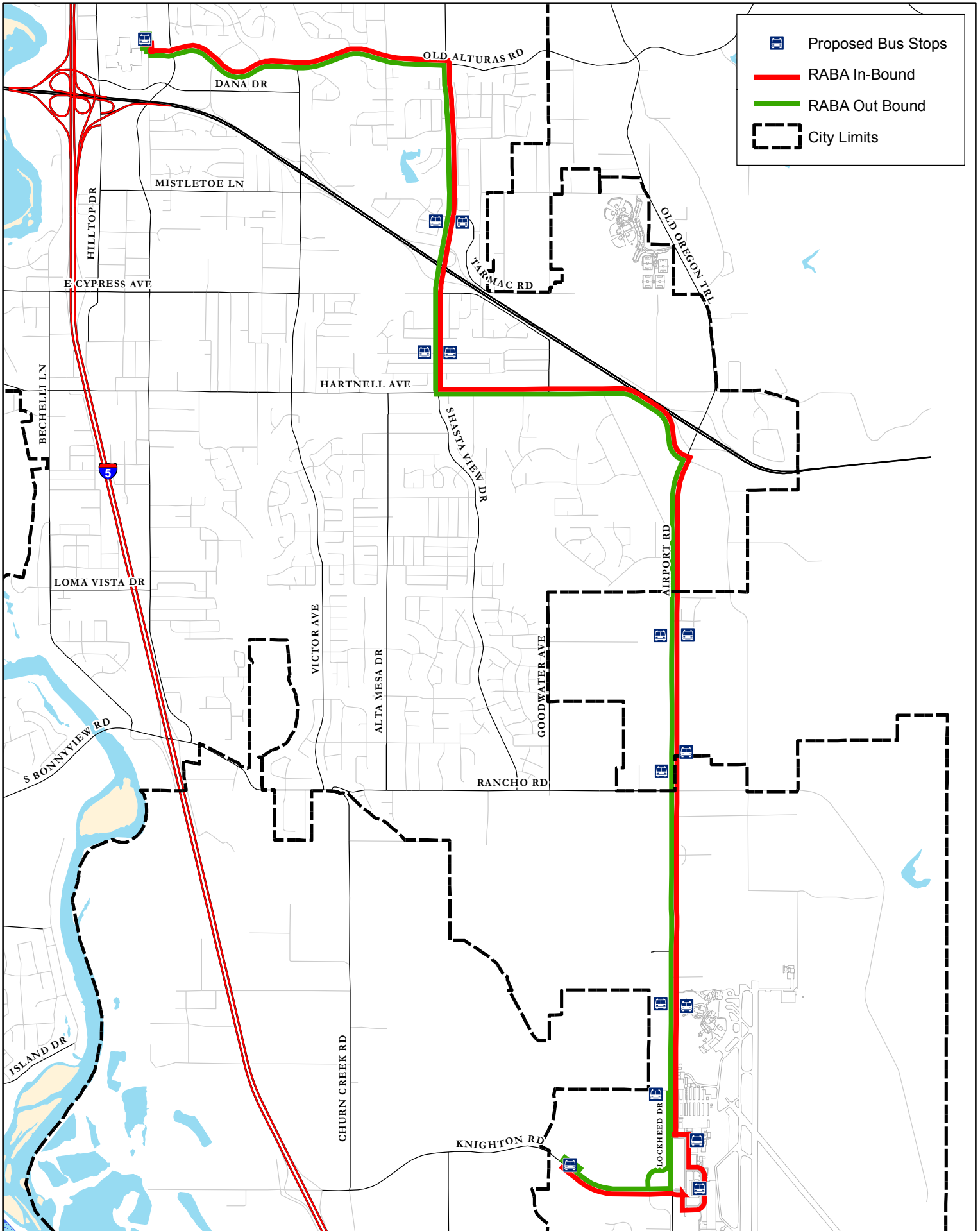


NEW-Airport Road Corridor Commuter Route
Start Date - October 3, 2011

The new service is approximately 20 miles in length. The Airport Road Corridor Commuter Route will start at the Canby Road Transfer Center and make eight stops outbound including service to the CalFire complex, IFT ground and flight campuses, the Airport, and the new Veterans Home once construction is completed. See the attached map for reference. The route will have a one-hour headway and run six times per day on weekdays and five times per day on Saturdays to correspond to peak commute times. The times will also be coordinated to ensure transfers with other routes can be made at the Canby facility. Because this route will be identified as a commuter route with limited stops and running during peak hours, complimentary paratransit, or demand response, service is not required.

As shown on the attached map, the proposed route will traverse the mile long section of Airport Road that is within the jurisdiction of Shasta County.
